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a PIECE OF CONSCIOUSNESS

What an incredible discovery! I have been entrusted by God to carry a beloved piece of consciousness through this lifetime. It is a divine spark, a tear drop of multi-colored light, like a seed whose light was once concealed within an ebony case and now appears as a prismatic bud of light, not yet entirely freed of the dark traces which were once its hull. I am frightened by the fragments of darkened hull which still attach to the seed. Am I brave enough to enter here? Will the blackness engulf me? Will I be lost or annihilated? I stop.

Now the seed transforms and reappears as an ear of corn, whose velvet husk of blackened green cannot totally obscure the light within. It is as though the darkened ear emanates an aura. I am strangely unafraid of the husk. How many shades of blackness are there, I wonder. This one seems especially beautiful to me, and I imagine that blackness must come in an infinite variety of hues and textures.

It is summer, my favorite time of year, and the sound of the cicadas rises and falls in rhythmic cadence. I am happy this morning, and in the split second before I identify this thought, that I am happy, I really am at peace. Quickly, however, a fear attaches to the thought. Will it last? How long can I sustain it? Happiness is transient and fragile, and can be snatched away at any time. Now I watch as the happiness begins to ebb, not altogether gone, but diminished. What has happened?

A cloud floats in front of the sun, its light temporarily diminished. That is all. It is that easy. I am changed. Suddenly, that which I believed to be fleeting, I now see is enduring. I have mistaken the passing cloud for the permanent reality behind it. I have believed it was the sun and not the cloud that was ephemeral. Just that one shift changes everything. It is happiness that is enduring, not the clouds which temporarily obscure it! Oh, hallelujah! I do not have to be afraid of the clouds anymore. They will always pass. They may be momentary whiffs that dispel on their own or they may be storms that I

have to abide, but they will move. They will pass away.

I have understood for a long time that life here has ups and downs. It is not that I have believed there should be no hardship; but I have grasped at happiness, fearing that I would lose it, rather than allowing its felt presence to ebb and flow with the rhythms that life brings.

Each morning I feel excited as I think of that piece of consciousness with which I have been entrusted. Somehow all the previous regrets, the guilt, the shame about what I have and have not done are irrelevant. The self who used to shrink away from who I was when I acted in unconsciousness is freed. The blacknesses, the husks and hulls, are all a part of the total creation that I have agreed to carry. They are only me, no more, no less. And some of them seem very beautiful — the rich dark sable of anger unnamed, the deep purple inkiness of passion suppressed. Are these mysterious clouds of color designed to attract me to explore their meaning? Is each a part of the prism of light that has been temporarily darkened. Have I come here to know them each a little or one a lot? Are they part of the gift, not part of the burden?

Here is my hope, my prayer — to know that I cannot fail, that I have never failed, to trust each step of the journey no matter where it takes me, to know that the clouds are part of what I have agreed to carry here and that they will part and disperse, and to recognize that every glimpse of the light illuminates my connection to all that is enduring. †
