CONNECTING TO THE GREATER REALITY

Interview with Nadya Beck - Guest Speaker at CCC Day

Nadva, tell us how you became involved Nadya, ten us ... with Pathwork.

A. I have always been a seeker – really, I think I was born a seeker. I always felt there was something more to life. When I was little, I would hear adults talking about Jesus Christ or God, and I would think to myself, "I am Christ. Anyone can be Christ." So early on. I had this sense of knowing certain things and wanted to learn more.

Then when I was eight years old, I had a spiritual awakening. I have always loved nature, and one day, I was lying on my back in a field with my dog, looking up at the sky. All of a sudden, this feeling just came over me. It was a physical and emotional experience of the bigness of life, of oneness, of interconnectedness. I knew then that there was more to life, that there was a

So as I grew up, I was always searching, always looking for that greater reality. I read as many books as I could find, including the Tibetan Book of the Dead, worked with the iChing, studied astrology and numerology - I was always reading and exploring.

During my 20s, I lived in New York City where I was part of the art community and music community. I was an artist myself, though I did not make my living as an artist, as I was never comfortable with the commercial aspect. To earn a living, I made films, had my own TV show and worked with performers as a manager - musicians mainly. I ended up working with some powerful

people, including John Lennon and Yoko Ono, | taught Helpership in Holland and created and Tina Turner. Again, I was always aware of Helpership programs in New York as well as the spiritual level, and with many of these musicians, I would find myself consulting with them on that level. Groups would come by sometimes as late as 3 am - to talk with me, and I was part of Tina Turner's spiritual awakening.

At one point, a friend introduced me to the Seth material (channeled by Jane Roberts), which I really see now as a precursor to discovering Pathwork. At the time, I felt this was what I needed, what I had been longing for - to have a teacher like that.

I later signed up for a program that was being offered by Kim Rosen (poet and author of Saved by a Poem) on the art of touch, which I loved. Kim asked me at some point, "Have you ever heard of Pathwork?" I said no and she said, "You have to do this." When I started reading the lectures, it was like finding home. And Kim became my first Helper.

Q. So it sounds like that was it - no turning back, ves?

A. Yes. I was so taken with Pathwork that I moved to be near the Pathwork Center in Phoenicia, New York with my family - my two sons and my future husband, who were also immersed in Pathwork. I just flew through the material. It woke up something in me that was already there and I often felt when I was reading the lectures, "I know this." It became my life, and I dedicated my life to Pathwork.

I became a Pathwork teacher and Helper in the New York Region. I was president of the Board, and later became Program Director. I

TRANSITION OF LEADERSHIP

Dear Pathworkers.

It is hard to believe that in June. I will have been the Spiritual Leader for this region for three years. It is time for the transition to new leadership. As I sit here writing this for the Spring/Summer newsletter, we Helpers are actively involved in what we call the "Calling Forth Process." Just as the Bishops in Rome have their rituals for discovering the new Pope, we Helpers gather in our own way to ask God to call forth one or more Helpers to be the next Spiritual Leader(s) for the Philadelphia Pathwork Community. It is a sacred spiritual Pathwork tradition.

First in the process, each helper is asked to spend whatever time it takes to come to neutral. This means that each of us explores all our inner voices: the ones screaming "No way, not me!" and any voices that may be wanting the position for less than sacred

reasons such as, "I want the power, the specialness, etc." (Since the position requires lots of time, energy, and responsibility there are fewer, if any, of these voices but we look.) We ask, "What could be the blessing if I am not the one called?" and "What could be the blessing if I am the one called?"

Eventually we come to the place where we are each feeling neutral about the answer to the guestion... "Am I being called by God to be the Spiritual Leader for the Philadelphia Pathwork Region?" This is the place where each is willing to surrender to the will of God knowing that no matter what we feel consciously, God's will and our own inner will are the same. Some of this work may be done independently but we give voice to all the voices in us when we meet as a group.

The next step in the Calling Forth Process is for the Helpers to gather and place a chair
